

**RESOLUTION**  
**of the**  
**HARDYSTON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY (“HTMUA”)**  
**regarding**  
**AUTHORIZATION FOR HYDRANT USE BY HARDYSTON TOWNSHIP**

**WHEREAS**, at its regularly scheduled meeting of July 1, 2013, the HTMUA Commissioners discussed a request from Hardyston Township for permission to use certain HTMUA-owned hydrants as a water supply for Hardyston Township employees and equipment engaged in municipal street sweeping activities in the pursuit of public safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the HTMUA Commissioners discussed the propriety of such hydrant use and the protection of said hydrants in order to enable them to function properly in emergency situations;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commissioners of the HTMUA as follows:

1. Hardyston Township is granted permission to utilize non-metered, HTMUA-owned hydrants for the purposes of supplying water for municipal street cleaning.
2. This permission is conditioned upon the presence and supervision of such hydrant use on every occasion by a properly-trained employee of either the HTMUA or of Hardyston Township.
