WHEREAS, the Authority, the Township and the Borough desire to enter into an agreement to address each party's respective financial claims associated with the Property in a form substantially similar to the form agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the Hardyston Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

- 1. That the Board hereby authorizes and directors the Authority Administrator to execute an agreement with the Township and the Borough addressing each parties financial claims related to the Property in a form substantially similar to the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
- 3. That the Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute the documentation and agreements, subject to legal counsel review, necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
- 4. That this Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
