



Hardyston Township Community Garden 2012 Registration Form



- **Initial Registration Window: April 23rd – Noon on May 4th**
- **2012 Fee:** \$40 for 1 4x8 raised bed plus a shared 6x12 flat bed
- Cash or check will be accepted. Checks should be made payable to the Township of Hardyston. Please note that plot rental fees are non-refundable.
- There are 24 plots available. In the event that there are more applications received than there are plots available, the Township will hold a lottery to assign plots. In the event you do not receive a plot your registration fee will be refunded to you and you can be placed on a waiting list. In order to ensure that the greatest number of residents have an opportunity to participate you will only be able to register for one plot. In the event that there are additional plots available at the close of the registration window any remaining lots will awarded based on a lottery system. The fee for a second 4x8 plot will be \$30. Please indicate on the registration form whether you would like to be considered for a second plot.
- Your completed application form must include a signed and witnessed Hold Harmless Agreement, signed Gardener's Commitment (last page of rules and guidelines), and be initialed that you understand and agree to abide by the rules and guidelines of the Hardyston Township Community Garden (Rules are provided separately or are available on the Township website www.hardyston.com).
- Please note that community garden members are required to volunteer at least 6 hours throughout the garden season to general maintenance of the public garden or working in the charity garden. Kindly indicate where you would like to volunteer your services on the application below.
- **A mandatory orientation program for the Community Garden will be held the week of May 14 – 18th, additional information will be provided upon being granted a plot.** Registrants will be assigned their bed and receive access to the garden, review the rules and guidelines, and learn how to start a raised bed garden, receive organic gardening tips, and talk with Master Gardeners about gardening questions.
