  - 3. Fred Heyer, P.P., and Heyer Gruel & Associates, Inc., for planning services for the period of January 1, 2017, through December 31, 2017, in accordance with the contracts made a part hereof.
- 4. These contracts are entered into without competitive bidding as a "Professional Service" pursuant to the non-fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.
- 5. A copy of the resolution will be published in the official newspaper of the Township within 10 days of passage.
