

**MINUTES OF THE HARDYSTON TOWNSHIP COUNCIL WORKSHOP MEETING
HELD ON APRIL 12, 2017**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Kula at approximately 7:00 P.M. with the opening statement that the meeting had been duly advertised and met all the requirements of the Sunshine Law. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

A. Low and Moderate Income Housing Ordinance Modification

Carrine Kaufer, Municipal Planner explained that the purpose of this Ordinance is to amend the existing very low, low and moderate-income housing ordinance of the Township of Hardyston Township Code to update it in accordance with the Township's Mt. Laurel constitutional affordable housing obligations. This Ordinance was placed on the regular meeting agenda to follow for the Council's consideration.
