
## New Jersey Cancer Education and Early Detection Program (NJCEED)

Provides breast and cervical screenings for women who are typically underserved. The program is funded by the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services and the Center for Disease Control (CDC). We provide free health screenings to women who have little or no insurance, and meet the income eligibility criteria. Screenings take place at various times and locations throughout Sussex County. This screening includes a free Pap test, Pelvic Exam, Clinical Breast Exam and Digital Mammogram.
