Dear fellow Veteran,

On September 6, 2014, we dedicated the new veterans memorial honoring the military service of all of our veterans, especially those who reside in Hardyston Township. The memorial, a stately engraved granite monument, is located at the Hardyston Township Municipal and Police Complex at the existing flag pole area. In addition to the monument, an "Honor Walk" surrounds the monument, and is constructed out of brick pavers. Each of the pavers will be individually engraved in order to honor a specific veteran, listing his/her name, branch and date of service. These engraved pavers honor veterans, living or deceased, who either live or have lived in the Township of Hardyston at some point in their lives. To date, over 100 veterans have participated. I invite you to join me on the honor walk by procuring a brick with your name or the name of a relative or loved one.

We have negotiated with a local company who will provide the pavers. The cost for engraving and delivery is \$39.00 per brick. We encourage our veterans and the families of our honored veterans to consider purchasing a brick to commemorate their service and become part of the legacy of honor that we have created in tribute and respect of those who have committed themselves to military service.

In an effort to reach as many potential veterans as possible, we also ask for your help in locating other eligible veterans who may not be reached by this letter. Kindly let Patty know if there are additional veterans that you are aware of that may not have been notified of this opportunity, so that we may also contact them and offer them to participate in this endeavor. If you would like to participate, but are unable to afford the paver fee, please contact us. While our resources are limited, we want to make sure that all of our veterans have an opportunity to be honored.

Please note that the Honor Walk is an ongoing effort, and we will continue to take orders for memorial pavers continually into the future.

We once again want to sincerely thank you for your service and hope that you can join us in this exciting and honorable project.
